EDA Regional Economic Impact Analysis

Analyze regional tourism trends and related economic impacts with a goal of leveraging tourism to increase economic development in the Western U.P.

Partnership with *U of M Economic Growth Institute*

- Develop partnerships and tourism estimates (county-level data collection)
- Gather market intelligence on spending habits and activities
- Conduct economic impact (input/output) modeling
- Produce final report including, by county:
 - Key tourism industries
 - Economic impacts
 - Visitor profiles, including destinations visited
